Plaintiffs Developmental Pathways, Inc., Douglas Abraham, Adams County Economic Development, Inc., Anne L. McGihon, Daniel E. Williams, David Getches, and Frank Weddig, and Defendants Bill Ritter and The Colorado Independent Ethics Commission (the “Parties”), by and through their respective counsel, hereby provide this Court with the following Joint Status Report.

1. On March 9, 2009, the Parties filed with the Court a Joint Status Report and Joint Motion to Reset Status Conference. On March 16, 2009, the Court ordered the Parties to jointly contact the Clerk of Courtroom 11, no later than March 23, 2009, to reset the Status Conference to be held before April 30, 2009. The Parties jointly contacted the Clerk of Courtroom 11, setting the Status Conference for Tuesday, April 14, 2009, at 4:00 p.m., to take place in Courtroom 11.

2. On March 18, 2009, Plaintiffs filed their Unopposed Motion for Leave to File Fourth Amended Complaint. The Court granted the Motion on March 23, 2009, and Defendant Colorado Independent Ethics Commission submitted its Answer to the Fourth Amended Complaint on March 26, 2009.

3. On March 26, 2009, Defendant Bill Ritter filed with the Court a Motion to Dismiss. Plaintiffs’ and Defendant Colorado Independent Ethics Commission’s response to the Motion is due Monday, March 13, 2009.

4. The Colorado Independent Ethics Commission’s most recent Advisory Opinion and Letter Ruling were filed with the Court by Plaintiffs on April 2, 2009.

5. This case is not yet at issue due to the pending Motion to Dismiss submitted by Defendant Bill Ritter.
