<b>JOINT STATUS REPORT</b>			

Plaintiffs Developmental Pathways, Inc., Douglas Abraham, Adams County Economic Development, Inc., Anne L. McGihon, Daniel E. Williams, David Getches, and Frank Weddig, and Defendants Bill Ritter and The Colorado Independent Ethics Commission (the “Parties”), by and through their respective counsel, hereby provide this Court with the following Joint Status Report.

1. On March 26, 2009, Defendant Bill Ritter filed with the Court a Motion to Dismiss. On April 24, 2009, Plaintiffs filed with the Court their Response to Defendant Ritter’s Motion to Dismiss. On May 4, 2009, Defendant Colorado Independent Ethics Commission filed with the Court its Response/Objection to Defendant Bill Ritter’s Motion to Dismiss. Defendant Ritter has not replied to either of the responses filed to his Motion to Dismiss.

2. Plaintiffs have filed all of the Independent Ethics Commission’s Advisory Opinions, Letter Rulings and Position Statements. Plaintiffs have amended their Complaint accordingly.

3. Prior to the upcoming Status Conference, Plaintiffs anticipate filing a Fifth Amended Complaint, which will dismiss certain plaintiffs and add an additional plaintiff in this case.

4. Plaintiffs believe that the case is at issue now.

5. A Status Conference is scheduled for Friday, July 24, 2009, at 4:00 p.m. All parties are required to appear in person.
