

## Contributions to Colorado State Legislators

Colorado State Legislators that aren't seeking public office outside of the legislature raised \$251,787 from January to July 18, 2017. Democrats raised \$194,307, three times as much as Republicans at \$57,479. Democratic Representative Faith Winter raised the most at \$47,759, followed by Republican Representative Paul Lundeen at \$27,000.

Most of the money raised was for future Colorado State Senate campaigns.

- \$142,647 was raised for 14 future Senate campaigns (4 Republicans, 10 Democrats)
- \$90,903 raised for 36 future House campaigns (11 Republicans, 25 Democrats)
- \$18,236 was raised by Colorado State Legislators that have yet to declare future campaigns
